## Grainger Steps Up to Support Affordable Housing in Portland Volunteer Event Follows \$30,000 Donation from The Grainger Foundation to Support REACH Community Development

Portland, Ore. (August 1, 2009) – Today, more than 280 volunteers will lend a hand to help paint and repair more than 22 homes of low income seniors at the 20th annual REACH Paint-and-Repair-a-thon with one of Portland's largest affordable housing developers, REACH Community Development.

Local facilities maintenance supplier, Grainger, has stepped up to offer more than 30 employee volunteers and their families to help. In addition to volunteer support, local Grainger branch managers Jeremy Deeney, Rolando Calderon and Mike Hoxie will present a \$30,000 donation to REACH on behalf of The Grainger Foundation.

The donation will be used to support REACH programs, including Resident Services, Youth\$ave, and the Community Builders Program. REACH also offers a free home repair program to Portland's low-income seniors, providing repairs such as building wheelchair accessibility ramps and home painting. The Community Builders Program is a wonderful opportunity for concerned citizens to become involved in revitalizing their community.
